

ACCESS TO SENDAI



By Railway

JR Tohoku Shinkansen connects Sendai and Tokyo. It takes about 1hour and 40 minutes from and to JR Tokyo and JR Sendai and requires you to make a seat reservation. Yamabiko have some unreserved seating, but it takes about two hours. The single journey costs about $10,000 \sim 11,000$ JPY.

By Air

There are some direct international flights to Sendai from Incheon International (Seoul. Korea), Taiwan Taoyuan International (Taipei, Taiwan), Pudong International (Shanghai, China), Beijing Capital International (Beijing, China), Suvarnabhumi International (Bangkok, Thailand), Guam / Honolulu (USA). Domestic services to/from Sendai are available at Shin-Chitose, Narita International, Chubu International, Komatsu, Osaka International, Kansai International. Kobe. Hiroshima. Fukuoka, Naha. Sendai Airport is located about 20 km from the Sendai city center and can be accessed directly by train (15-25min.) or bus (40min).
